
These can be briefly listed here:

Promotion Policy: (Nursery to Xth)

- Every student is required to get a qualifying grade D or above in all the subject excluding 6th additional subject as per scheme of study for the purpose of promotion to next class.
- If a student fails to obtain qualifying grade D in one or more subjects, even after adding grade point from co-scholatic areas and after availing one improvement chance, he/she will be required to repeat the same class during next academic year.

Promotion Policy : (Class XIth)

- A students who does not secure the required atleast 33% marks in all five subjects but secures a minimum of 33% in that subject may be considered for promotion to the next higher class provided his/her aggregate in all subject is not less the 60%.
- In case of subject involving practical work a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% in practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in that subject.



Admission Procedure

dmission is open to children of all communities and faith, subject to availability of seats. The registration for admission is generally made in the month of March or according to instruction issued. The prospectus along with admission form which is available at the school office on payment Rs. _____ Completed registration form must be submitted in the school office before the last date has been notified by the school. Short listed candidates will be required to appear in the entrance test consisting of four papers i.e. English/Hindi /Mathematics/ General Science and interview. List of selected candidates will be notified on the school notice board, such parents shall have to deposit the requisite fee and avail the seat within three day from the day of declaration of result."

At the time of admission of child the following requirement shall have to be fulfilled by the parents:

School fees as per rule.

School leaving certificate/transfer certificate duly signed by the head of the institution from the school last attended and counter signed.


Original date of birth certificate where applicable.

Set of prescribed uniform/books/Stationery.

Age: The child should complete 3 year of age by April 1, for admission in Nursery, 4 years in Jr. KG, 5 years in Sr. KG, 6 years in class I and so on.


